

This is a lovely little wander through Chiswick and Hammersmith, with some short tube journeys along the way. It includes indie bookshops and charity bookshops and it links up really well bookshops in Central London if you've still got energy at the end! Start at Bookcase London (268 Chiswick High Rd, W4 1PD), a new and remainder bookshop where you'll find great bargains, and follow this up with a trip to Waterstones (220-226 Chiswick High Rd, W4 1PD) as you pass. Cross the road and you'll find long established second hand and antiquarian bookshop Foster Books (183 Chiswick High Rd, where you can lose hours browsing. Keep walking and before you reach Turnham Green Station you'll pass Oxfam Books (, where you can find lots of second hand bargains.



From Turnham Green station you can either take a short walk, or take the District line one stop to Stamford Book and walk down the road to brand new indie bookshop Everybody Reads (6 Chiswick High Rd, W4 1TH), and finally finish up with another short walk, or another short District line trip to Books for Amnesty (175 King St, W6 9JT), the original amnesty charity bookshop.

When you're finished, you can easily jump on the District line back to the bookshops of Richmond & Kew, or head into Central London and explore there using the Big List.
