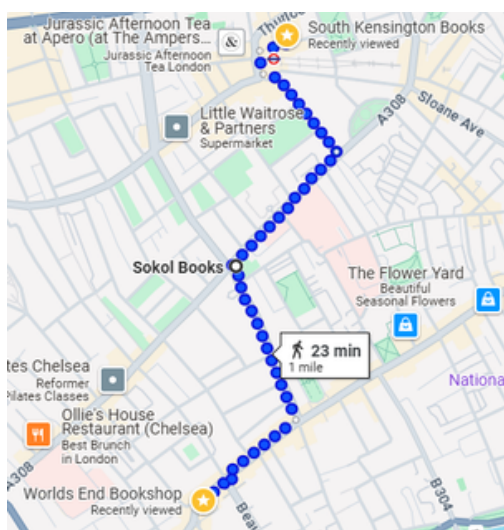


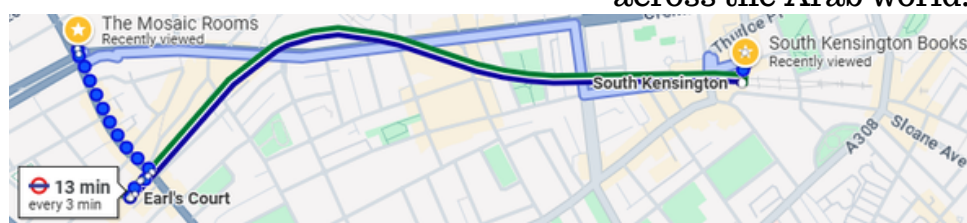
Kensington & Chelsea Bookshop Crawl

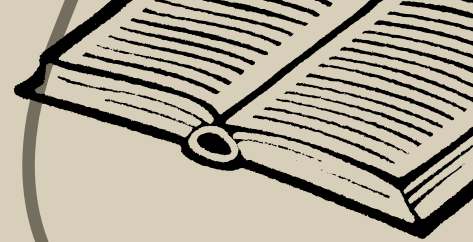


This route takes in several very unique bookshops and can be done entirely on foot, or if you prefer, including a short tube journey at the end. Start at long established and much photographed book treasure trove John Sandoe (10 Blacklands Terrace, SW3 2SR). Once you have managed to tear yourself away, pop into Waterstones (158 Kings Rd, SW3 3NR) on your way past. Keep on down the King's Road and you'll reach World's End Books (357 King's Rd, SW3 5ES), home to a small selection of curated second hand books across a range of subjects.



From here, a short walk will bring you to Sokol Books (239A Fulham Rd, SW3 6HY), a rare and antiquarian bookshop specialising in English and Continental books published up to 1600. After this, another 10ish minute walk takes you into the museum district and South Kensington Books (22 Thurloe St, SW7 2LT), a lovely independent bookshop with a great range of books. Finally, take the Piccadilly or District line from South Kensington to Earl's Court and walk to The Mosaic Rooms (226 Cromwell Rd, SW5 0SW), where you can explore the gallery as well as the bookshop which stocks books, zines and prints from across the Arab world.
