

Ballam, Clapham & Batterse **Bookshop Crawl**



This route takes in quite a big area, but it de the itely worth it! Including some real hidden gems and ending up at Battersea Bookshop, where several events are happening through the weekend, with an eclectic route of bookshops along the way.

Begin in Balham at the Oxfam Bookshop (nearest station Balham, overground & northern line). When you're done here, walk down the road to Backstory, where you can also grab a coffee, glass of wine or snack along with your books! If the weather is nice, walk 25 minutes to Fara Bookshop which specialises in an amazing array of children's books as well as general fiction and lots more (be warned that although it doesn't look big, it's very easy to spend an hour+ here!). If the weather is bad, take the 155 or 249 bus from Balham New Road



A short walk from Clapham Books is children's bookshop with a twist, Chocolit, which alongside their great range of children's books for all ages (and adults who love kids books too!) also sell amazing chocolate!

To end your crawl, take the 452 bus from Silverthorne Road (Stop D) to Battersea Park/Chelsea Gate or the 156 bus from Prairie Street (Stop R) to Battersea Dogs & Cats Home and walk to Battersea Power Station, where you'll find Battersea Bookshop on the ground floor of turbine hall B! For your efforts you'll be rewarded with a discount on production of your bookshop crawl ID card, and make sure you check the programme as there are events happening here throughout the weekend
