


This is an adventurous bookshop crawl, made for those who like a little journeying into the unknown (or the known, if you're a local!). It takes in 5 bookshops with two bus journeys, or a train and a bus journey and a couple of 15 minute walks, and you can do it in either direction.

For the purposes of this itinerary we'll be starting at Oxfam Bookshop, Wanstead (1 Clock House Parade, E11 2AG). Once you've had a browse of the bargains to be found, you'll embark on your first public transport stint of the bookshop crawl, either getting the Central Line from Wanstead to Leyton with a short walk either end, or getting the W12, W13 or 66 bus from Wanstead Place (Stop SE) to Leytonstone Stn and walking.




Phlox Books (159 Francis Rd, E10 6NT) is your next stop, a beautiful indie bookshop where you can also get a locally roasted coffee, craft beer or natural wine with your books. Once you're done here, a walk with bring you

to Quinto Bookshop, once stalwart of the Charing Cross Road, who relocated their second hand and collectible bookshop to 679 High Road in June 2024



Jump on the bus (69 from Leyton Midland Road Station, Stop NA to Walthamstow Central Station, and walk to Waterstones (Selbourne Walk Shopping Centre, E17 7JR). A final walk will bring you to Public Knowledge Books (90 Hoe St, E17 4QS), one of the newer additions to our bookshop crawl lists!
