


Haringey Bookshop Crawl




This route encompasses some great indie bookshops, with a few charity bookshops in there and two fantastic children's bookshops. It involves a couple of short bus journeys, and an optional detour along the way!

Begin at the All Good Bookshop (nearest station Turnpike Lane, Piccadilly Line), a cooperatively owned indie bookshop that also plays host to all sorts of local groups and events. Then take the 41 bus from Wood Green High Rd (Stop Q) to Crouch End Broadway/Park Road (10ish minutes)



Walk around the corner to amazing children's bookshop Pickled Pepper Books, where you can also grab a hot drink and a snack! Nearby are Oxfam Books & Music, and House of Books, both great, budget friendly options for your bookshop crawl! If you're in need of a brunch or lunch stop, Bookshop Crawl recommends Organic & Organic Cafe (just down the road from Pickled Pepper Books)for amazing breakfasts and sandwiches.

Take the W7 bus from Crouch End Broadway (Stop CD) to Muswell Hill Broadway (less than 10 minutes), and walk around the corner to the Oxfam Bookshop for charity supporting bargains! Stop in to House of Books on your way to the final stop of the crawl, The Children's Bookshop, and help them celebrate 50 years of bookselling!
