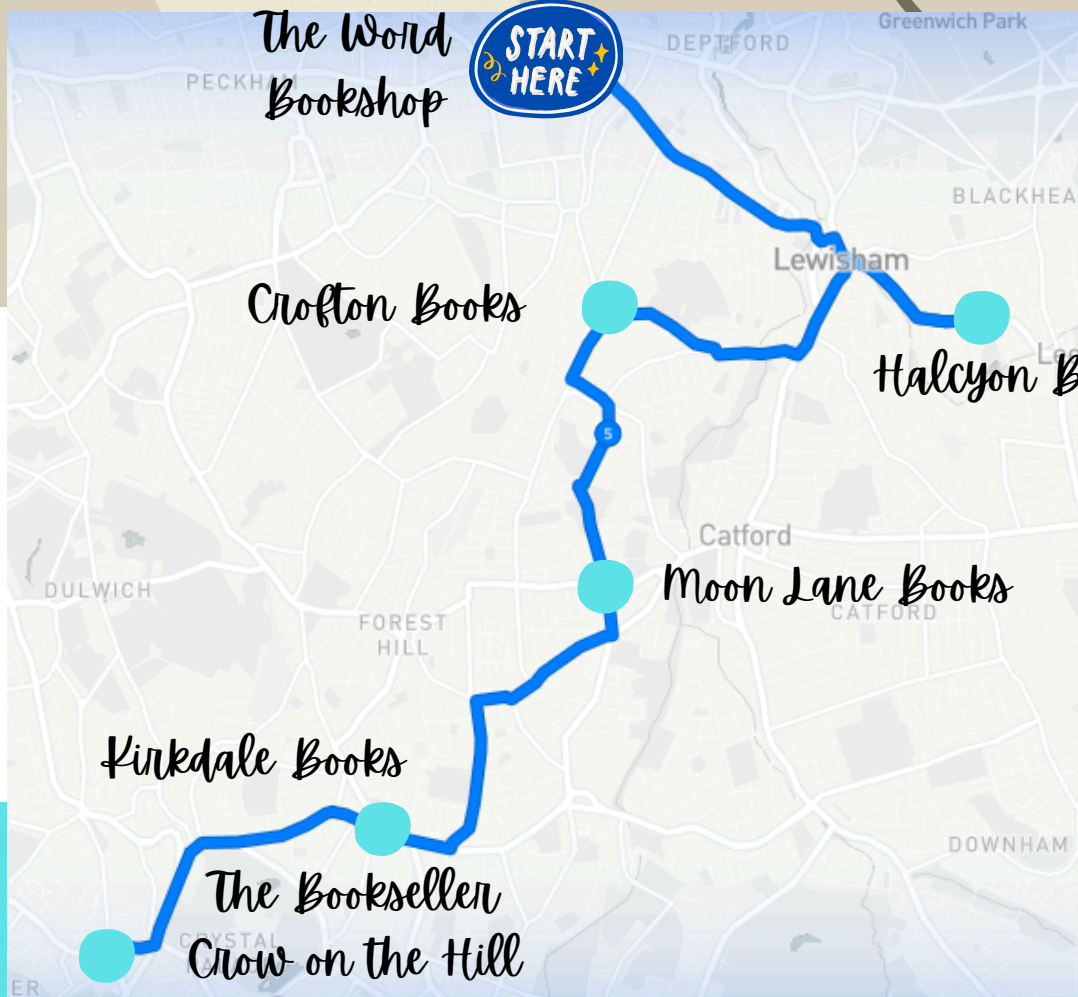
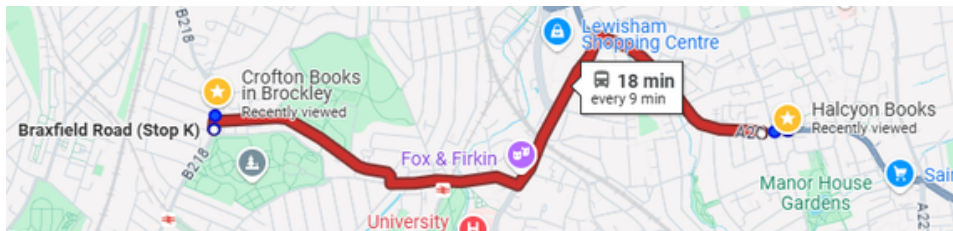


Lewisham & Crystal Palace Bookshop Crawl



Many buses are involved in this bookshop crawl, but it's worth it we promise! It takes in a big stretch of London and includes a wide variety of bookshops. Start off at The Word Bookshop (314 New Cross Rd, SE14 6AF), and then jump on the 321 bus from Marquis of Granby (Stop T) to Brandram Road and walk to Halcyon Books (266 Lee High Rd, SE13 5PL), a family run second hand bookshop packed the unexpected for you to find.

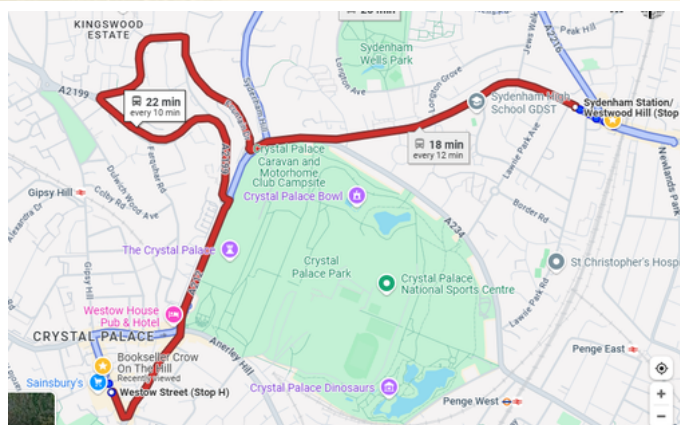
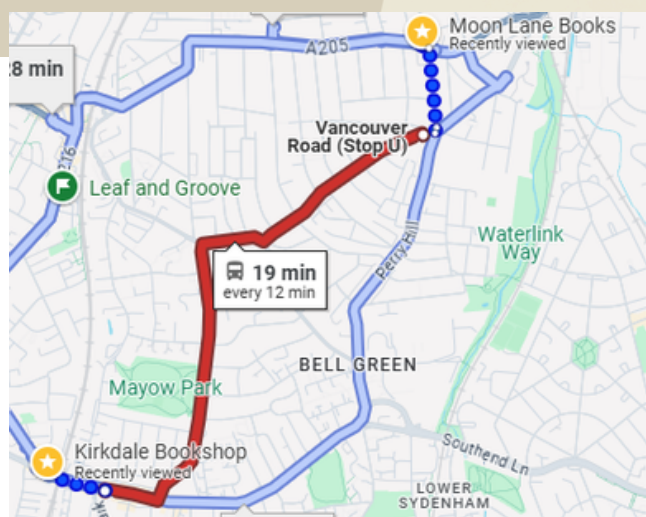


Another bus ride on the 122 from Brandram Road (Stop U) to Braxfield Road and walk to Crofton Books (315 Brockley Road, SE4 2QZ), a second hand and new bookshop where you may find some fun extras with your bookshop crawl ID card...

We're incorporating a brilliant children's bookshop into this bookshop crawl, with a short ride on the 171 bus from Braxfield Road (Stop K) to Blythe Vale and cross the road to Moon Lane Books (300 Stanstead Road, SE23 1DE), a CIC dedicated to improving equality in children's books.

Take the 75 bus from Vancouver Road (Stop U) to Newlands Park and walk to Kirkdale Books, probably the oldest indie bookshop in south east London, with a big range of books across all genres.

Your final bus of the day takes you to another long established indie bookshop. Get on the 450 from Sydenham Station/Westwood Hill (Stop C) to Westow Street and walk to The Bookseller Crow on the Hill (50 Westow St, SE19 3AF)



This is a suggested route only provided for the purposes of helping you organise your crawl. Feel free to follow it in whatever order and way you think best. Please check the Big List for details of any extras on offer over the weekend.
