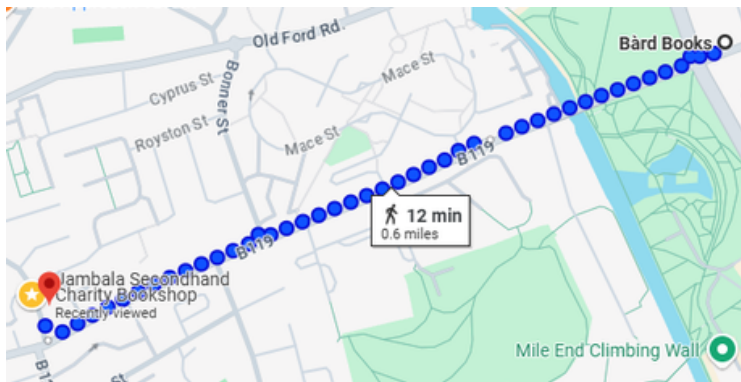
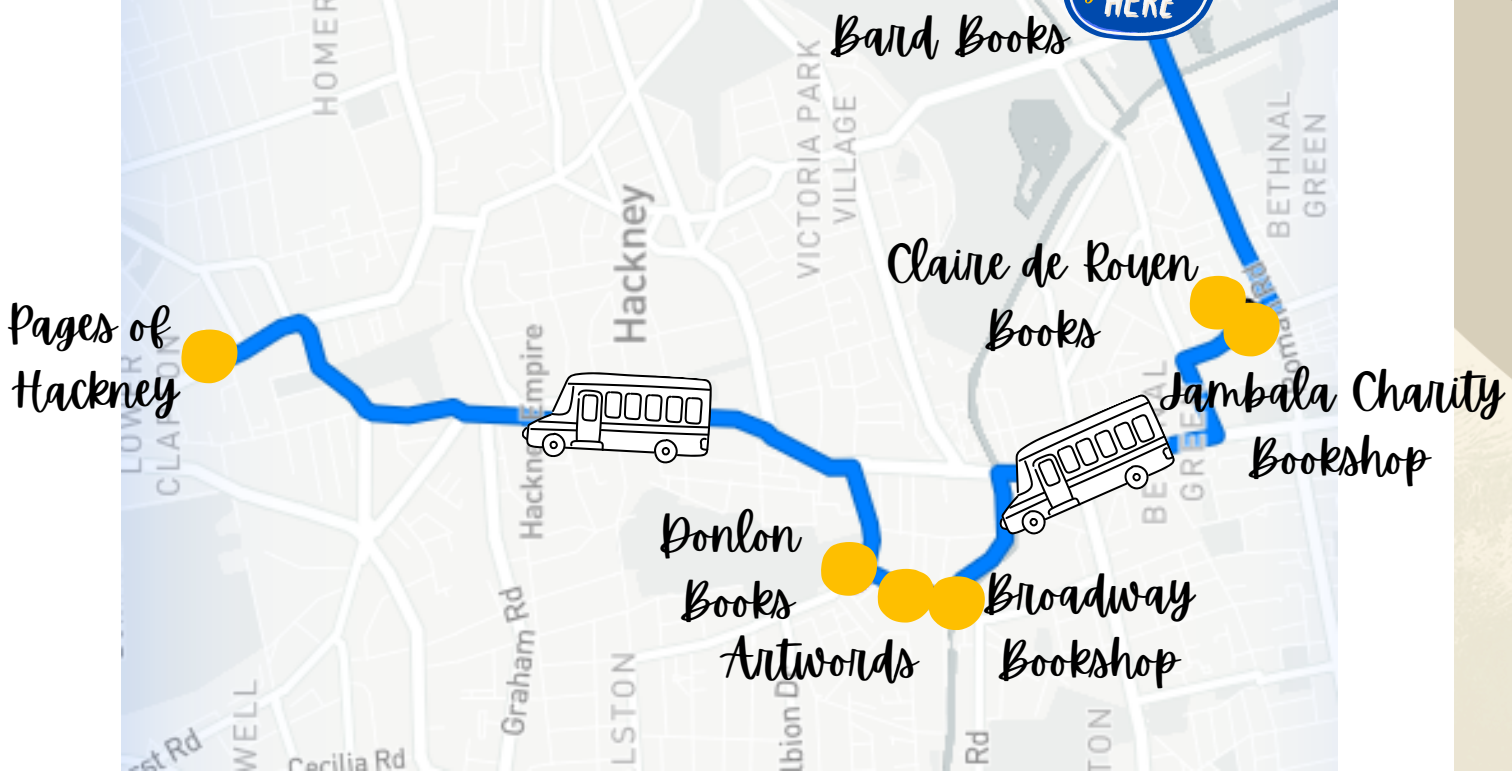
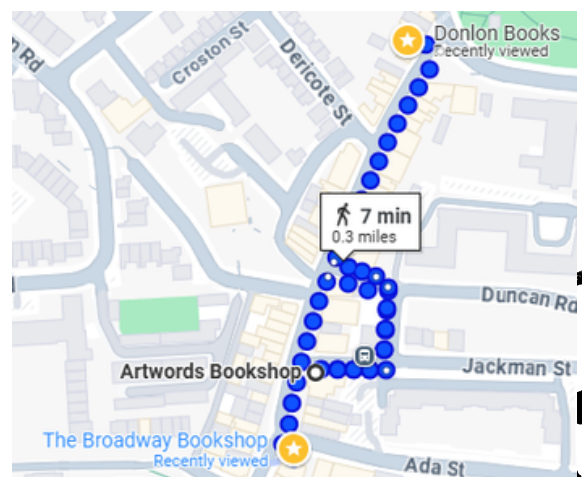


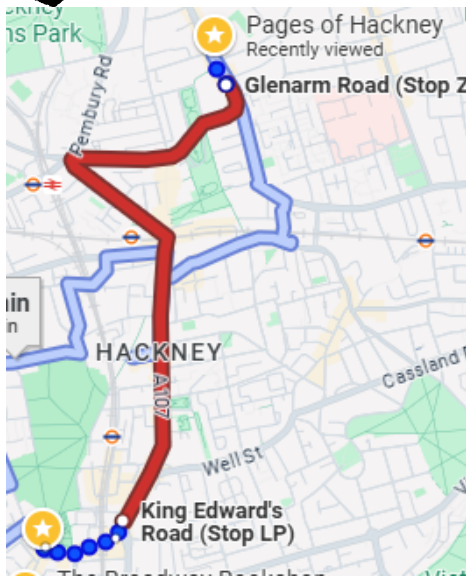
Hackney & Bow Bookshop Crawl



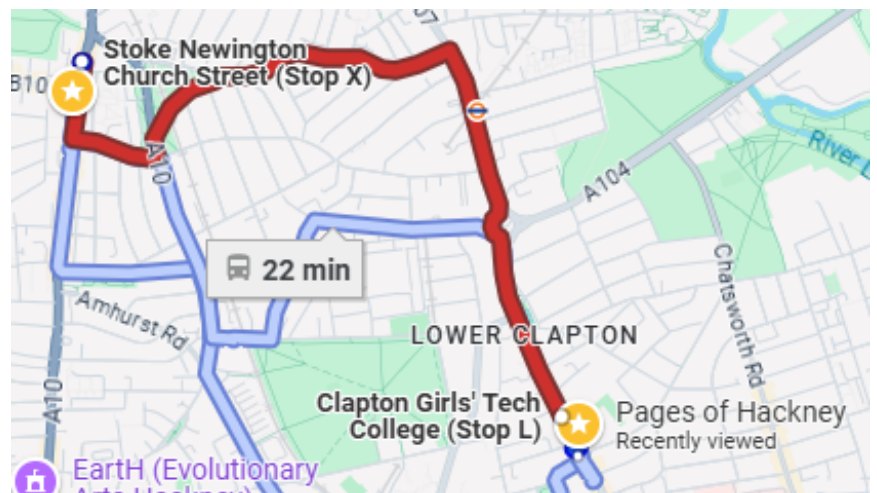
Start this epic undertaking at one of the newer bookshops on our list, Bard Books (341-343 Roman Rd, E3 5QR), an indie bookshop created for the local community. A 10 minute walk from here will bring you to recently relocated Claire de Rouen Books, previously an inhabitant of the Charing Cross Road and now continuing the legacy at 260 Globe Road, Bethnal Green. Over the road at 247 you'll find Jambala Charity Bookshop, which is the bookshop of London Buddhist Centre and sells all sorts alongside the selection of books!

A longer walk of 20 minutes (or a 15 min trip on a bus, number 338/106/254 or D6 from Old Ford Rd Stop G to Mare St/Victoria Park) will bring you to the delights of Broadway Market, which as well as being a great place to get lunch, houses several bookshops including our next stop, The Broadway Bookshop, which specialises in literary fiction with a good range of other things as well! For the art lovers amongst you, a 4 minute walk away is Artwords (books about contemporary visual culture), and another 4 minute walk from there is Donlon Books, which is both indie bookshop & publisher.





Take the 55, 106 or 254 bus from King Edward's Road (Stop LP) to Glenarm Road, and walk up the road to beautiful indie bookshop Pages of Hackney (70 Lower Clapton Rd, E5 0RN). Don't forget to explore the basement too!



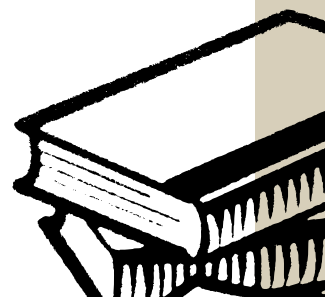
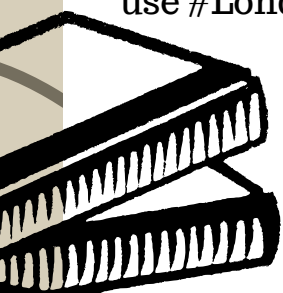
If you have energy for one last bus journey, take the 106 from Clapton Girls Tech College (Stop L) to Stoke Newington Church Street and walk up the road to lovely, spacious indie Stoke Newington Books (159 Stoke Newington High St, N16 0NY).
